Highly conductive solids are a great challenge for common thermal characterization methods. The measurement resolution often does not suffice to characterize thermal conductivity with satisfying accuracy or merely provide indirect results derived from thermal diffusivity measurements like laser flash analysis.

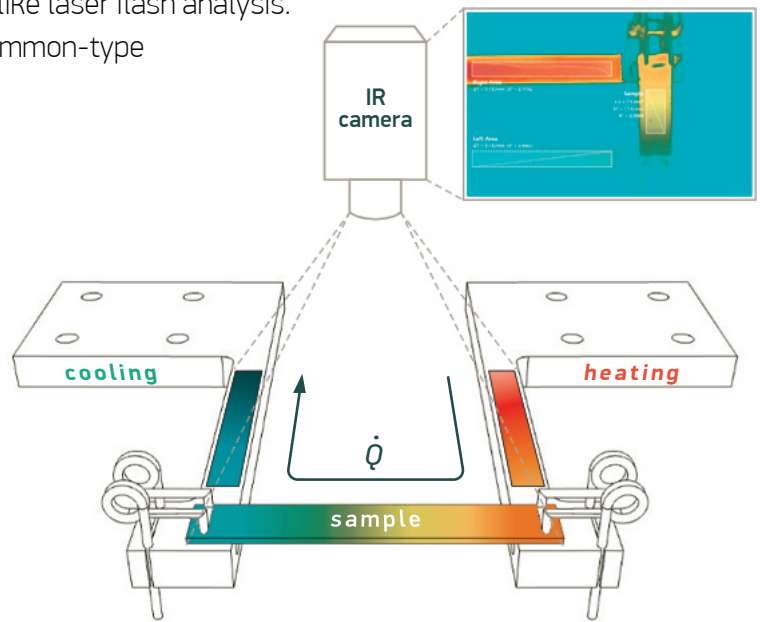
Additionally, samples with dimensions necessary for common-type characterization are usually difficult to fabricate.

- Bulk thermal conductivity as direct result

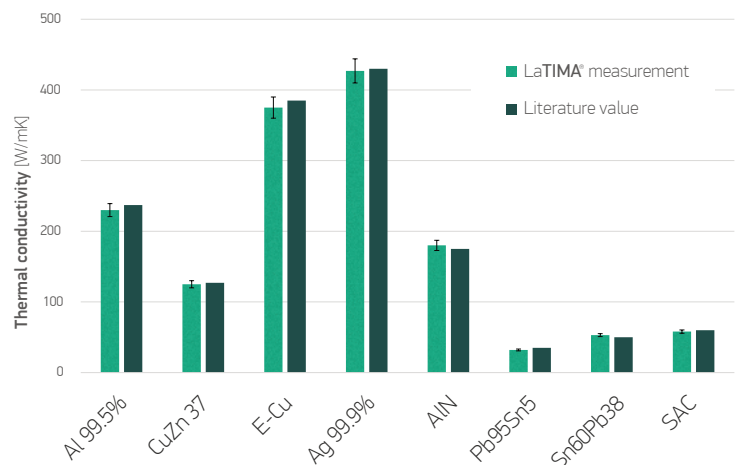
Sample range

- Glass, ceramics, anisotropic material



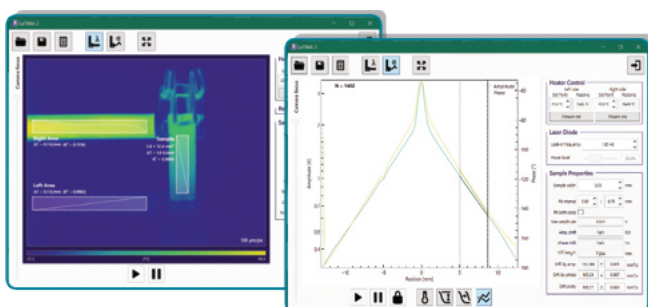
The standard that doesn't need a standard
